College and University Applications

Now is the time for you to impress the college admission offices with your achievements. It takes hard work to guarantee that your college or university application stands out. What can you do to make your application rise to the



top of the pile? You need to become familiar with the application process and get organized. There are a number of moving parts that you need to manage as you apply to colleges or universities— tests, essays, recommendation letters, transcripts, and more. Each element has a specific deadline.

Our Primary Responsibilities

Academic Guidance

Success Pathways provides "real" English writing exercises and training to improve skills faster. Our academic guidance is not a simple paper modification. Continuous support for writing is also



provided during the application process. Service Process

First Consultation

Pre-Stage Application Process

- Develop an overall academic plan and timetable

- o Identify potential applicant institutions and major
- Give advice based on the student's specific background: standardized test b. internship c. research d. activity e. other

Mid-Stage Application Process

- Evaluate student highlights and determine the "best fit" for college or university application taking the following four criteria into consideration:
 - o 1. Standardized Tests
 - 2. Internships, Research Options and Summer Jobs
 - 3. Balance of Courses
 - 4. Extra-Curricular and Community Service Involvement
- o Develop a list of potential colleges/universities
- Conduct systematic writing guidance on Essay(s), Personal Statement and Resume, including content, structure, logic, and language
- Academic guidance for course selections

- o Instruct students to determine the best outcomes for recommendation letters
- Prep and coach for college interview (not all schools conduct or require an interview)
- Finalize edits for Essay(s), Personal Statement and Resume
- Assist with online application requirements and submit all materials (transcripts, recommendations, etc.), including deadlines/follow up to complete the process
- Communication with the admissions officers and college/university professors
- o Track emails regarding admission process

Final Stage Application Process

Once admission to college or university is offered:

- Assist in the analysis of admission decisions, including overview of majors, location type of institution, etc.
- o Provide advice to select enrollment at college or university of choice
- o Guide to submit supplementary materials such as enrollment deposit and final transcript
- Follow up with matriculation process, including Orientation, Housing and 1st Semester Course Selection
